DIRECT A SHOW: Direct the means and method for the outcome of any film or audio project by communicating with the producer and talent.

HOST A PODCAST: Become a podcaster by creating and hosting your own show, invite guests, have conversations and publish your content.

BE A FIELD VIDOGRAPHER: Utilize station field cameras to seek out and film events around town, with the help of the town calendar, to capture the essence and activity within the Wethersfield Community.
